TRAP RANGE SAFETY RULES

1. Any person showing willful disregard for these rules will be removed from the premises.
2. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
3. Never point a firearm at anything you do not wish to shoot.
4. Eye and hearing protection is required
5. All shotguns must be unloaded and actions open when transporting to and from shooters vehicle, to and from firing line and when changing stations.
6. Shotguns will be placed in the gun rack with the actions open. Break open shotguns will be closed in the gun rack.
7. No firing is permitted in front of the 16yd. Line.
8. No loaded guns allowed except while on the firing line and ready to fire.
9. In the event of a malfunction, it is the shooters responsibility to keep his gun pointed downrange, until the range master determines otherwise.
10. Only one shell is to be loaded for singles and a maximum of two for doubles.
11. All shotguns will be unloaded and actions open before anyone goes downrange to fill or check the trap house.
12. Personal traps and portable traps are welcome on non-scheduled trap days.
13. All decisions of the match director are final.
14. Clean up after yourself; Pick up your hulls, and dispose of your trash.
15. The trap range is for shotguns only. Please do not shoot the back of the trap house or drive on the concrete.
16. REMEMBER---SAFETY IS NO ACCIDENT.
